



2022 College Scholarship

The Michigan Soybean Association (MSA) is now accepting applications for their college scholarship program. MSA members, as well as the children and grandchildren of members, between the ages of 17-25 are qualified. Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student at a post-secondary education institution during the Fall 2022 semester in order to be eligible. **All applications must be received by the Michigan Soybean Association office by August 1, 2022.**

At least two scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each will be awarded. Finalists will be asked to participate in on-site interviews at the Michigan Soybean office. Checks will be mailed upon confirmation of enrollment in the Spring 2023 semester. Students are only eligible to win an MSA scholarship **one time**.

Applications must include an MSA membership number. Only one application per membership number will be accepted. If you do not know your membership number, please contact the soybean office at (989)652-3294.

MSA membership costs \$75 for one year, \$190 for three years or \$20 for a young farmer membership (18-24 years). MSA membership automatically includes membership in the American Soybean Association. If you would like to become a member or learn more, visit misoy.org or contact the Michigan Soybean office.
